

Enabling (MFA)

MULTIFACTOR AUTHENTICATION



MFA adds an extra layer of security to your accounts and apps. It confirms your identity to grant access. This is done through a code sent via text, email, or generated by an app; or biometrics like a fingerprint or facial recognition.

How to Turn on MFA



Go to Settings

May also be called Account Settings, Settings & Privacy, or similar.



Look for and turn on MFA

May also be called two-factor authentication, two-step verification, or similar.



Confirm Your Selection

Select your extra login security method - a code sent via text, email, or app; using a fingerprint or facial recognition.

Enabling MFA adds an extra step to access your accounts, but it protects them from malicious hackers!
