Age of Hardware

The **average lifespan** of a computer is **3-5 years**, although mileage may vary depending on usage, maintenance, and needs. And **not having a warranty** could **decrease lifespan**.

Computers malfunctioning, slow, or shutting down constantly? These are signs that you may need to <u>repair or replace</u> them.

Operating System

The program that manages all the other application programs on your computer or server must be current. If end-of-life (EOL) it doesn't receive security updates or support from the developer. And your dental software may not be compatible.
