Haven't Started

Still fully on Windows 10, haven't taken action yet.

- ☐ Inventory every Windows 10 computer + note if domain-joined
- ☐ Sort each into Upgrade / ESU / Replace
- ☐ Get pricing for each path before deciding



On ESU

Enrolled in Extended Security Updates, buying time.

- ☐ Confirm which ESU program you're on (Consumer vs. Business)
- ☐ Confirm your exact expiration date
- ☐ Build your upgrade/replace plan before ESU runs out



Mixed Fleet

A combination of Windows 10, ESU, and Windows 11.

- ☐ Build one physical master list
- ☐ Flag each computer by category (Upgrade / ESU / Not Started)
- ☐ Prioritize any computer still fully unpatched



Already Upgraded

Some or all machines moved to Windows 11.

- ☐ Confirm every computer is on Windows 11
- ☐ Confirm imaging/X-ray/PM software is validated on Windows 11
- ☐ Check operator computers specifically (commonly missed)

Key Dates

- **Oct. 14, 2025:** Windows 10 end of support
- **Oct. 13, 2026:** Consumer & Business ESU (Year 1) coverage ends
- **~Oct. 2027:** Business ESU (Year 2)* coverage ends

***Note:** Business ESU pricing roughly doubles in Year 2, plan accordingly.
